GENERAL DESCRIPTION

DEFINITION



RPHC is the process of systematically obtaining and recording the Demographic, Economic and Social data at specified time of country's population



In Rwanda, the Population and Housing Census is conducted once in ten years

RPHC OBJECTIVES



To Determine size of Population



To Determine the Demographic, Social and Economic characteristics of population



To Determine Trends of Mortality Fertility and Migration



To Determine the population Projection



To Determine the Household and Housing Condition



Constitute the update Sampling framework that should be used in future sample survey

Dissemination






POPULATION SIZE (1978-2012)

In 2002 and 2012




POPULATION GROWTH RATE

Number of Inhabitant per Square Kilometer




LIFE EXPECTANCY BY SEX (%)
