


FERTILITY BY PROVINCE

Average Number of Children per Woman




At current fertility levels, a woman in Rwanda will have an average of 4 children in her life time

BY MOTHER'S EDUCATION




Generally, fertility decreases as education level increases







CHILDHOOD MORTALITY


Deaths per 1000 live births

Percent of children under 5 based on 2006 WHO child Growth Standards




Stunting Decreases as mother's education and household wealth increase

Knowledge about HIV transmission and prevention


