Figure 4.16: Higher Education learning students Enrollment








Figure 4.17: Student enrolment in tertiary education in Degree awarding institutions







Figure 4.20: Profile of tertiary education students per 100,000 inhabitants by sex



 $Figure\ 4.21: Profile\ of\ tertiary\ education\ students\ with\ disability\ in\ 2013$ 




Figure 4.22: Profile of tertiary education staff by nationalities in 2014





Figure 4.23: Number of computers and internet connection in tertiary education by sector of education, 2014


